


**Multimedia Mapping Process**

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This workshop provides hands-on experience in creating interactive maps that automatically link a GPS track log coordinates and images. Clicking on a map pops-up the photo or video associated with a location. On the Internet, multimedia maps become alive with sights and sounds of locations, such as hiking trails, infrastructure assets, real estate offerings, schools and other facilities. MediaMapper<sup>TM</sup> software by Red Hen Systems is used in the workshop with reference to related software supporting ArcGIS and Google Earth.
